

3.0 POLLUTION

3.1. Anti-pollution regulations apply within the marina which is a NO DISCHARGE zone.

3.2.A sewage pump-out facility is provided On the End of B. Training about its operation is provided to mooring users by the Marina Manager who is available to provide additional advice on its use.

3.3. Marina users shall observe the operating instructions for the sewage pump-out facility.

3.4. The use of vessel toilets sinks and showers which discharge through the hull is prohibited whilst the vessel is within the marina and its adjacent waterways.

3.5. The discharge of polluted effluent from manual and automatic bilge pumps whilst within the marina is prohibited

3.6. Washing or hosing down of vessel topsides is permitted using water

from the service pedestal only. Any detergents used must be biodegradable and environmentally friendly.

3.7. The bottom scraping of vessels whilst at the marina is not permitted.

3.8. Antifouling paints containing tributyl tin, organo tin or other hazardous compounds are pollutants and degrade water quality. Owners of vessels using antifouling paints of these types must make application in writing to the Marina Manager to enter the marina.

Management has implemented a regular water quality testing program in order to monitor the local marine environment and detect any pollution sources

3.9. Major repairs, sanding, grinding, painting or refitting of vessels at the marina is prohibited.

3.10. The cleaning of fish within the marina or upon the docks is prohibited. There is a fish cleaning area adjacent to the rubbish bins and trolley stand.

3.11. All leakages or spills of fuels, oils and other hazardous substances must be reported to the Marina Manager immediately.

Refuse, garbage and plastic bags shall not be thrown overboard, all general rubbish must be placed in the bins provided within the compound in the carpark. Both general waste and Recycling bins are available Waste oil, Fuel and Batteries must be disposed of by the boat owner or contractor. These items are not, under any circumstances to be place in the general rubbish bins or area.

4.0. SAFETY

4.0. Marina users shall make themselves familiar with and understand the emergency response plans and procedures including adherence to the directions given by the Marina Manager.

4.2. Welding, oxy cutting and other such hot work shall not be carried out on the marina or on any vessel berthed within the marina.

4.3. No garbage, batteries or other waste materials shall be permitted to be placed or left on the docks. All garbage shall be disposed of in the receptacles provided or as directed by the Marina Manager.

4.4. Any debris within the marina and surrounds which is considered to be hazardous to safe navigation shall be reported to the Marina Manager.

4.5. Marina users shall exercise caution and adopt procedures for the safe use of electrical equipment near the water.

4.6. No swimming, Diving, fishing or collecting of shellfish is permitted within the marina.

5.0. MAINTENANCE

5.1. All damage caused to the marina, the marina surrounds or other vessels must be reported to the Marina Manager immediately.

5.2. All defects in or malfunctions of the mooring equipment or marina infrastructure must be reported to the Marina Manager immediately.

5.3. Marina users must keep and maintain the marina berth and any vessel in a clean and tidy condition and in good repair. Docks are not permitted to be used for the maintenance, repair, painting and other works on moored vessels.

5.5.All contractors working on a vessel must be an approved contractor and MUST sign in at the marina office for each visit. The marina office shall hold a copy of theircurrent appropriate licenses and insurance.
